

Cleaning During An Outbreak

1. Disinfect

- Apply approved chemical at proper concentration and contact time per label.
- Rinse after if required by label.
- Kills germs

Does surface come in contact with food, hands, mouths, eyes, or noses?

⇒ Examples: tabletops, toys, sleeping mats, high chairs, etc.

2. Wash

- Use soap and water
- Removes high concentration of disinfectant

3. Rinse

- Clean water
- Removes soap which interacts with sanitizer in the next step

4. Sanitize

- Apply approved chemical at the proper concentration and contact time per label

Bleach **Outbreak Disinfectant**

Note: Other chemical disinfectants may be used. Seek health inspector approval prior to use.

1 Cup Plain Bleach

1 Gallon Water



Indigo Instruments High Chlorine Test Strip

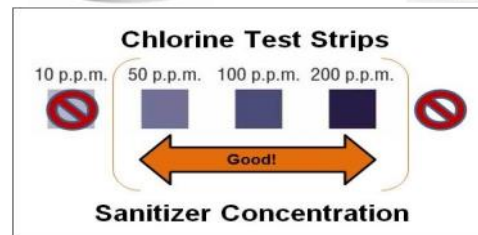
Concentration must be 5000ppm or above.

Bleach **Sanitizer**

(Tabletops and Toys)

1/2 - 2 Teaspoons
Plain Bleach

1 Gallon Water
