Waste Collection

There was a total of 67,833 pounds (34 tons) of hazardous materials collected. This figure includes:

- 41,475 pounds of paint
- 1,530 gallons of motor oil
- 5,833 pounds of pesticides
- 1,600 pounds of aerosol cans
- 306 gallons of acids and bases
- 270 gallons of antifreeze
- 65 pounds of devices containing mercury

This figure does not include 324 tires, 249 gas cylinders, 163 automotive batteries, and 19,512 pounds of electronic waste.

There was a total of 168,937 pounds (84 tons) of hazardous materials collected. This figure includes:

- 132,875 pounds of paint
- 1,725 gallons of motor oil
- 11,085 pounds of pesticides
- 3,400 pounds of aerosol cans
- 600 gallons of acids and bases
- 760 gallons of antifreeze
- 405 pounds of devices containing mercury

This figure does not include 545 tires, 435 gas cylinders, and 539 automotive batteries.
