### Recycling Fees:

Computer Monitors . . . . .	\$8	All other electronics	
TV's (any size) . . . . .	\$15	depending on size . . . . .	\$0-\$2

(Cash or Checks only.)

Acceptable electronics include computers, printers, data devices, TV's, small appliances, cell phones, stereo equipment, and most items with a plug. We cannot accept large appliances, air conditioners or any item with refrigerant.

General household hazardous waste will also be collected at this event (no asbestos, radioactive, or compressed gas accepted). If you have questions about a hazardous item please call. A payment of \$20 is requested to help offset the high cost of hazardous waste disposal.

Open to residents of, and sponsored by: Adams County (Unincorporated), Brighton, Commerce City, Federal Heights, and Thornton. You will be asked to show a utility bill, phone bill, or driver's license with your name and address.
