- ⇒ Increased illnesses in school/classrooms
- ⇒ Suspect outbreaks
- ⇒ Reportable diseases, i.e. pertussis, E Coli
- ⇒ Animal bites or contact with wildlife
- ⇒ Needle sticks and blood borne pathogen exposures

- ⇒ Expanding or remodeling a kitchen utilized to serve school children
- ⇒ When adding before/after school, summer, or pre-school programs
- ⇒ When there is no hot water or no water at all in the school
- ⇒ When remodeling a building that was built prior to 1978 or remodeling any early childhood classroom(s) (preschool, before and after care, summer camp)
